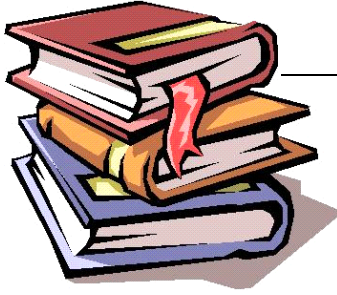
Lighthouse Small Group Bible Studies
